This person is responsible for scripting and some programming as it relates to essential duties and responsibilities.

It requires both strong technical expertise, as well as the ability to effectively partner with others for the best outcome. This role requires the ability to work cooperatively with all staff levels, and a demonstrated record of dealing with confidential matters in an objective and professional manner.

Technical Leadership Requirements:

- Work with the Information Technology Manager in the analysis, acquisition, installation and maintenance of software and hardware throughout the Bank
- Work with team members to determine standards and procedures for production Implementations
- Research and implement new applications on workstations and servers
- Assist the IT Manager in ongoing risk analysis, identification and implementation of appropriate controls, and monitoring of those controls.
- Work with the IT Manager and the Bank Auditor to establish an ongoing program to monitor and test IT controls.
- Maintain appropriate documentation related to network architecture
- Provide necessary input and feedback for software version use, training and documentation, etc. as required on the project deliverables.



Technical Abilities & Proficiency:

- Serve as the primary administrator for certain software systems according to established department procedures.
- Provide administrative services for the customer and employee base
- Provide first and second level support for internal employees
- Maintain and design Active Directory topology
- Proficiency in group policy design and deployment
- Manage network security, including monitoring of appropriate logs, password administration, monitoring of firewalls and intrusion prevention/detection devices, and other activities to insure the security of the Bank network; coordinate vendor assistance when necessary
- Manage the Bank's WAN/LAN, including routers, switches, hubs and other devices
- Manage the bank's VoIP system and other PBX phone systems
- Serve as database administrator for the Bank, with responsibility for monitoring and maintaining critical Serve as Backup Administrator for the Bank, insuring that critical systems are regularly backed up and stored according to established policies and procedures. SQL, Access and other databases
- Serve as the Exchange Administrator for the Bank
- Serve as the WSUS Administrator for the Bank by monitoring, testing and releasing new patches to workstations
